Policy: Create governance and supporting policies to support initiatives and change.
Funding: Secure money for implementation, sustainability, and growth.

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Communication: Design authentic and reflective interactions that focus on two-way messages.
Community Engagement: Plan considers town meetings, radio, TV, and social media to communicate with the community.
Marketing: Uses all media formats to communicate and collaborate with education stakeholders.

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Teacher Support: Initiate and cultivate instructional practices that support blended learning in the classroom.
Human Capital: Introduce proper resource coverage to implement blended learning environments.
Professional Development: Encourage participation in PD opportunities using multiple models of blended learning.

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Student Buy-In: Inspire student choice/voice in setting their pace, place and time for learning.
Student Engagement: Provide access, devices and structures to engage students to meet and exceed learning goals.
Student Achievement: Foster use of tools for students to assess and implement solutions for real world problems.

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Infrastructure: Provide LAN/WAN equal to 1 Mbps per student to access all district-provided e-learning resources.
Connectivity: Support wired and/or wireless network access for all devices.
Home Access: Promote consistent access equal to school infrastructure.

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Digital Course Design: Enable and encourage teachers to provide 'home grown' blended resources and content.
LMS Integration: Ensure blended online environment meets needs of students, teachers, and administrators.
Content Choices: Cultivate teacher input into the selection of right blended digital content.

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Strategic Planning: Collaborate with schools, teachers and partners to support and manage district goals.
School Models: Implement flexible learning structures to meet student learning styles.
Measurements: Employ all available data application tools and measures to support and evaluate learning goals.

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Hardware: Support initiatives (1:1 & beyond) that meet the needs of both student and instructor.
Software: Innovate application(s) to seamlessly integrate technology into cross-curricular units for instruction.
Tech Support: Advance technology support both on and off campus for students and teachers.
